through screening of service record and interview of the candidates from member countries. After the service duration had finished, based on excellent performance, Board of CPSC Director had decided to continue the service as Director General CPSC. Colombo Plan Staff College is an international organisation with 16 member countries.

Innovation at Colombo Plan Staff College

- 1 Create Teaching and Learning System via online named OnCOURSE (Online Course via Ubiquitous and Realtime System of Education) to replace the teaching and learning system which is not in line with digital era.
- 2 Publish for the first time in Colombo Plan Staff College history, international journal with the title STEPS (Scholarly Technical Education Publication Series) that publish academic papers in Technical Vocational Education at international level.
- 3 Provide Online Journal Management System for management and editing process of academic paper before it has been published in journal.
- 4 Initiate the idea of creating CAPTVEC (CPSC Asia Pacific Technical and Vocational Education Centers) where institutions and agencies of Technical Vocational Education in Asia Pacific region could be awarded as exemplery centre in this field.
- 5 Create E-Applications at CPSC, in line with the action of reducing papers and CPSC greening initiatives. Amongst, the use of online forms for on leave application, staff movement, finance supervision and transport application that cannot be done previously. Publication and news also have been done through website. Also the use of online questionnaires to get research response about the training requirement and the future of member countries in line with the Corporate Planning Process.
- 6 Revise accreditation documents for Asia Pacific Accreditation and Certification Commission (APACC) such as APACC Instrument, APACC Guidelines and APACC Manual to ensure it is more objective and to demolish any ambiguity.
- 7 Introduce for the first time the training system, examining and certification to the APACC accreditors to enhance the number of accreditors in order to overcome the massive request.
- 8 Activate the honorary membership in CPSC for organisation that has been recognised at international level and non members of CPSC.
- 9 Produce finance resources from Customized Programs until it could replenish 20 percent of CPSC budget requirement. Also creating a collaborative programme with other Development Partner with sources sharing method and budget for similar targetted group, to ensure the Unit Cost of Programs decreased while the number of participants increased.

- 10 Introduce an initial effort between CPSC and Philippine government hence CPSC will be exempted from Value Added Tax (VAT). This matter is still on discussion and nearly comes to the approval.
- 11 Implement salary coordination at CPSC for professional staff and supporting staff based on performance where the increment is equally to the yearly performance level.
- 12 Introduce corporate credit card with internal control to save cost and to speed up the payment i.e flight tickets where it is more cheaper if it is purchased via online through credit card.
- 13 Create Most Valuable Partner' (MVP) Award to appreciate the participation and contribution from various organisations that have a working link to CPSC.
